YMCAs of Greater Hyderabad, Secunderabad Summer Camp has been an annual feature for over 4 decades which was introduced in the early 80's by the YMCA itself, which also remained a model for many schools, colleges and NGO's to adopt the concept. However the credibility what YMCA carries can't be matched with such entities, wherein it has produced many prominent Politicians, Bureaucrats, Sports Men & Women etc. over these decades.

The year 2022, YMCAs of Greater Hyderabad, Secunderabad Summer Camp was conducted from April 27th to May 28th 2022 concluded with Valedictory Function at Secunderabad YMCA, where more than 250 children from 5 years of age to 16 years have participated and learned many valuable etiquettes from the trained & experienced teachers/resource persons.

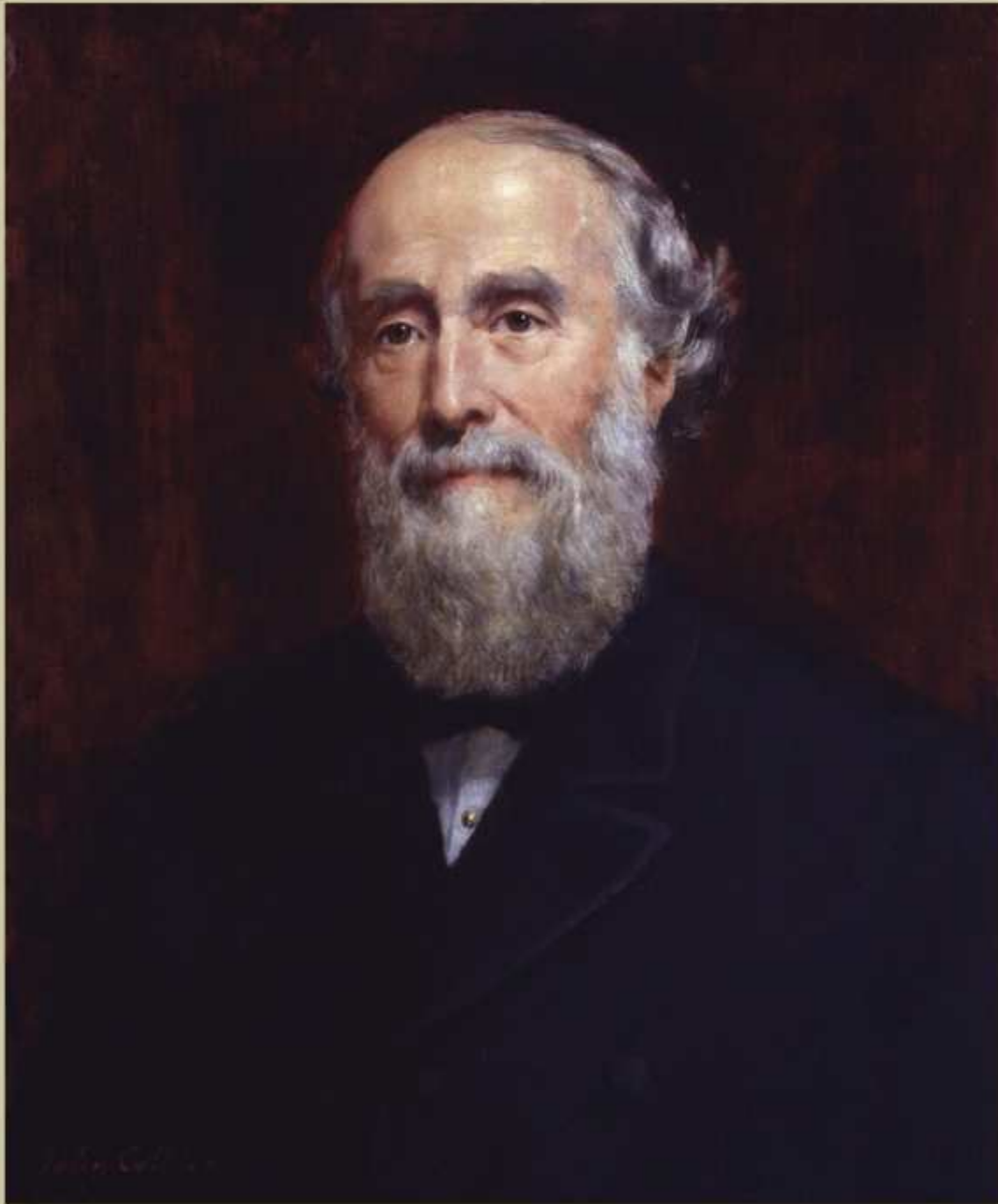
